

# Children's Liturgy of the Word

Children's Liturgy of the Word is offered during 10:30 a.m. Mass for children ages 4 years old through the second grade. No pre-registration is necessary and all children are welcome and encouraged to attend.

Shortly after the start of Mass, our presider will invite the children to leave the larger assembly and gather in the Reception Room to hear God's word at an age appropriate level. The goal is to provide lessons that are fun and relevant to the lives and experiences of young children in our parish family. The children will be introduced to both the structure of the liturgical worship and the experience of worship so they grow in their love and understanding of God.

This celebration reproduces the liturgical, prayerful and ritual based environment of the Mass, but uses age appropriate language. The children sing an opening song, listen to readings, sing a Psalm and Gospel Acclamation, hear a Gospel reading and discuss what they have heard. They pray the Creed, share Prayers of the Faithful and return to church during the offertory to celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

Adult and teen volunteers are always needed to serve as Catechists, Readers, Song Leaders and Spotters.
